<b>Language Requirements</b>	<p><b>General recommendations</b>  <b>B1 level of Spanish/Catalan/English</b> is recommended to attend subjects taught in these languages.</p> <p><b>Specific requirements</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>A2 level of Spanish</b> is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degree of Psychology.</li> <li>- <b>B1 level of Spanish</b> is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Tourism and Hotel Management, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Architecture, Law, Social Work and Labour Relations and Employment and Master's Degree in General Health Psychology.</li> <li>- <b>B2 level of Spanish</b> is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degrees of Hispanic Language and Literature, Publicity and Public Relations, Journalism, Audio-visual Communication, Physiotherapy, Medicine, Human Nutrition and Dietetics and Nursing.</li> <li>- <b>Official certificate of B2 level of Spanish</b> is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Strategic Communication.</li> <li>- <b>B2 level of English</b> is mandatory to attend all the Master's Degrees taught in English.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>B2 official certificate of English</b> is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's Degree of English.</li> <li>- <b>C1 official certificate of English</b> or a <b>personal evaluation by the coordinator</b> is mandatory to attend higher courses of the Bachelor's Degree of English and the Master's Degree in Professional English-Spanish Translation/ Teaching and Learning English as a Foreign and Second Language.</li> <li>- <b>C1 official certificate of Spanish</b> is mandatory to attend the Master's Degree in Teaching Languages: Spanish as a Foreign Language, Professional English-Spanish Translation and General Health Psychology.</li> </ul>
<b>Academic Requirements</b>	<p>Students will have to choose, at least, 50% of the credits from the field of study under which they have been nominated and, therefore, agreed upon in the bilateral agreement.</p> <p>Students can make their <b>Bachelor's/Master's final project</b> at the URV, <b>except in the fields of:</b> Law, Labour Relations, Nursing, Medicine, Physiotherapy, Physiotherapy (EUSES), Physical Activity and Sport Science (EUSES), Nutrition and Dietetics, Audio-visual Communication, Journalism, Publicity and Public Relations, Geography, Territorial Analysis and Sustainability, Social Work, Tourism, English and Architecture.</p> <p><b>Training placements</b> in any field of studies can be allocated upon request by sending a CV and a presentation letter.</p> <p><b>Smile Programme:</b> work placements for incoming student, especially those who might wish to specialise in Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL), but also in French and Germany languages. Incoming students working as language assistants will obtain 6 ECTS credits after completing 40 hours of work placement.</p>
<b>Covid Restrictions</b>	<p>The incoming mobility of <b>Nursing</b> students and trainees is paralyzed during this academic course. The decision of resuming the mobility of <b>Medicine, Human Nutrition and Dietetics, Physiotherapy</b> incoming students, will be taken in June and will be communicated to all the partners.</p>
<b>Registration</b>	<p>Once the student has been selected to do a mobility period at the URV, exchange students must complete an online application and attach the required documents.</p> <p>At their arrival, the students must attend a welcome session, visit their academic coordinator and enrol the subjects of their learning agreement at the secretariat of their Faculty/Technical School.</p>
